

FCLE Eligibility

The civics literacy exam is required for students currently taking government, DE government or AP government.

The purpose of the test is to provide high school students the opportunity to pass the exam at the high school level.

The exam will become part of the curriculum at the college level.

DOE is requiring that all students taking government this school year take the exam, this is not tied to student grades or graduation.

Students may retake the exam to receive a passing score but they must wait 30 days before retesting.

There is no practice test available at this time however Clark Youngblood has sent all government teachers an example of a practice test.

Students earning a passing score on the assessment are exempt from the postsecondary civic literacy assessment required by s. 1007.25(4), F.S. There are no other statewide implications for accountability or school grades.
