

PSAT/NMSQT Opt Out

Santa Rosa County offers the PSAT/NMSQT to all 10th grade students at no cost.

- The PSAT/NMSQT includes reading, writing and language and mathematics components that focus on the knowledge and skills that are most essential for college and career readiness and success; it is also used as a diagnostic tool to measure and follow student performance and pinpoint areas for development.
- PSAT/NMSQT results provide high school guidance counselors with information to help identify students who may be ready to enroll and be successful in Advanced Placement and other college preparatory courses or identify students who may need additional instruction to do so.
- PSAT/NMSQT also allows students to receive a concordant score for the Algebra 1 EOC
- Passing the Algebra 1 EOC is a graduation requirement

Parents do have the opportunity to have their student opt out of taking the test on October 26th.

If you would prefer your student not participate in the PSAT/NMSQT please complete and return the lower portion of this letter and return to your school's guidance department by October 25th.
